

WARRANTY COVERAGE and AGREEMENT

All customer warranty registration cards are the responsibility of the dealer. Registration cards must be submitted/received within 15 Days of purchase date. Please be aware that any/all warranty work required will not be approved if the registration card is not found on file at the factory.

WARRANTY COVERAGE:

Warranty applied to all models manufactured on or after July 1, 2006 RH Boats... March,1 2014 Fish-Rite Boats.

- a) 6 months on all miscellaneous electrical and rigging parts
- b) Lifetime (to original owner) on any major structural defects, main seam weld which includes hull side, bottom, transom chine and center keel.
- c) Lifetime warranty can be transferred to the second owner at a fee of \$900 after submission, inspection and approval of water craft by factory to be transferred.
- d) Inboard Motors:
 - a. Marine Power & Kem – 2 year limited warranty
 - b. Commercial charter use including guide boats, water craft for hire etc. – 90 days
- e) Inboard Pumps:
 - a. Hamilton – 1 year
 - b. American Turbine – 2 years
 - c. Commercial charter use – 90 days

All warranty work performed must have prior approval from the factory via warranty application form faxed or e-mailed to RH Boats warranty department at 541-779-1552 or warranty@rhboats.com.

Final Warranty claim must be received at factory within 30 days of completion of work performed.

Any claim under a total value of \$150 will not require authorization from the factory.

RH Aluminum Boats will reimburse the dealer at 10% over dealer cost for any supplied materials or parts required. Warranty program pays a maximum hourly rate of \$75 per hour, as well as an administration fee of \$35 for all claims over the value of \$150.

If the factory deems fit to repair any warranty claim, it will be the responsibility of the owner of the product to ship the boat to and from the factory.

Lifetime Hull Warranty is canceled and or revoked if any damage to the hull (main seam weld which includes hull side, bottom, transom, chine and center keel) exceeding \$150 is not presented to the factory for approval for repair by the factory or written authorization is granted from the factory for such repairs to be made by an outside source.

DEALER RESPONSIBILITY:

Dealer must submit any defects noticed within 7 working days of receiving product. After which time it will be the sole discretion of RH Aluminum Boats whether to warrant claims received.

ITEMS NOT COVERED BY LIMITED WARRANTY:

- A. Paint, peeling, scratches, chips, blistering, flaking, chalking or fading
- B. Corrosion or damage caused by:
 - a. Fuel spills or over filling
 - b. Use of harmful cleaners or solvents
 - c. Electrolysis
 - d. Improper use of antifouling paint
 - e. Dissimilar metal
 - f. Salt water as a result of zinc anode absence, cathodic protection device and or improper storage/moorage.
- C. All parts not manufactured by RH Aluminum Boats – must be processed/warranted by the respective manufacturer.
- D. Upholstery, canvas, protective covers, carpet and wood
- E. Damages caused by
 - a. Freezing water or operation in subzero temperatures
 - b. Loading, storage & trailer hauling
 - c. Accident, theft or misuse
- F. Glass

PROCEDURE FOR WARRANTY REPAIR:

Once warranty application form has been filled out and submitted to the factory, the warranty department will attempt to respond/process your claim within two business days. Additional information may be required such as photos, in order to expedite the claim.

Warranty claims must include authorization number in order to be processed/approved regarding credit to your account. The factory will issue a credit memo to your account after such time that the warranty claim is approved. Copies of warranties claimed with engine or drive manufactured supplied components must be submitted to RH Aluminum Boats/Fish-Rite Boats for future reference.

Any and all warranty claims cannot be deducted from any invoices.

Any and all claims must be filed through a RH Aluminum Boats/Fish-Rite Boats dealer.

Any dispute concerning interpretation or enforcement of this warranty agreement between the dealer and or the retail customer will be tried in Jackson County, Oregon, USA. The prevailing party at trial or any appeal therefrom is entitled to reimbursement for costs and attorney fees as governed by ORCP 68. The parties may defer any dispute to binding, non-appealable arbitration through the Arbitration Service of Portland. Such referral requires the written consent of both parties.
